

When looking to maximize closet space questions to ask yourself:

- Who will be using the closet?
 - Yourself or will you be sharing it with someone?
 - If you are sharing the closet, how much space does each person get for their share? How will it be divided up?
 - 50%, 30%, 70% be realistic
- What is your budget? \$500, \$1,000, \$3,000 or over \$5,000?
- Do you hang everything? Or do you like to fold items and have them on shelves?
- How much long hang do you need?
- How much double hang do you need?
- How much shelving is needed for sweaters, jeans, or baskets?
- Do you need shoe shelves?
 - For How many pairs of shoes? Ladies shoes are 8 inches wide and Mens shoes 9 inches wide.
 - Boots? How tall?
- Do you want drawers?
 - Solid drawers for private things?
 - Wire drawers where you can see at a glance what is where?
 - How many drawers each?
 - How wide do you like the drawers?
- Do you own or rent?
 - If you rent, you can use European Modular and take with you when move and re-install in your new home.
- What is your style? See Photo Albums to see what you prefer.
 - European Modular with metal components and some melamine components or none (Flexible and adjustable)
 - Wood look custom melamine (custom look)
 - Wood Veneer with clear coat. (custom with real wood)

 - Molding for finished tailored look
